

Five dominions/colonies issued stamps to commemorate the 1947 Royal Tourof southern Africa. The talk will cover the portraits, the stamps, FD, Royal Train, and Royal Visit covers, and city/town covers from respective visit days, following the train's route chronologically. Covers with postmarks commemorating events such as the Opening of Parliament and the Princess's 21st birthday will also be shown. Most of the covers are "philatelic" but they do a nice job of telling the story.
